MAPPPD is the primary penguin population database that all stakeholders in the Antarctic Treaty system maintain. Grant also directs Black Bawks Data Science, a data management and analytical company. Grant and his wife Alex, who is also a marine ornithologist have two daughters, Dylan and River.
