She managed data for the IUCN Red List Programme for many years and was co-editor of the 1997 IUCN Red List of Threatened Plants.

Since 2015, Harriet has lead the rapporteur team for the International Whaling Commission biennial meetings.

Harriet has many years experience of the UK environmental grant making sector. She was a trustee of one minor environmental grant-giving trust for 30 years, worked as grant manager for a major UK based environmental grant-giving trust, and was Chair of the UK Environmental Funders Network steering group .
